Conditions of participation FOERSTERcademy

2 Validity

These conditions of participation apply to all FOERSTERcademy events, regardless of whether they are held in person or online.

3 Subject to change

The organizer reserves the right to change dates, locations and speakers for any training. If, for reasons beyond the organizer's control, an event planned as in-person cannot be held as scheduled, the organizer reserves the right to hold it online.

4 Registration and conclusion of contract

Registrations must be submitted in writing: via an online form, by email, by post or by fax. Registration applications will be considered in the order in which they are received.

The contract is concluded when the organizer confirms the registration. Confirmation of registration will be sent in writing by post, by email or by fax to the address provided by the participant. If a registration application cannot be considered by the organizer, this will be communicated immediately.

Publication of the event in the program does not constitute a legally binding offer. By registering, the participant accepts these conditions of participation.

Since the number of training places is limited, the organizer kindly requests timely registration.

5 Cancellation conditions

If registered participants are unable to attend a training course, they may cancel free of charge up to 30 days before the start of the course. All cancellations must be communicated in writing. Otherwise, if cancelling less than 30 days in advance, the fee must be paid in full. Of course, substitute participants may be named to the organizer in good time before the start of the training.

6 Cancellation by the organizer

The event may be cancelled by the organizer for good cause. In particular: if too few participants have registered to cover the costs; or for organizational or illness-related reasons if no substitute speaker can be arranged; or due to force majeure. The participant will be informed immediately and all fees paid will be refunded in full. Further claims are excluded.

The organizer is entitled to change the speakers or to postpone the schedule for good cause, e.g. due to speaker illness, as long as this is reasonable for the participants.

7 Payments

The full participation fee is to be paid before the start of the event, upon receipt of the invoice. The amount due is to be paid by bank transfer; please reference the invoice number.

8 Responsibility

Selection of the training is the responsibility of the participant. If prerequisites apply, these are noted in the description of the training in the program. The training content is carefully prepared by the organizer according to the latest state of knowledge and technology. Institut Dr. Foerster GmbH & Co. KG assumes no liability for how the acquired knowledge is put to use by the participant.

9 Certificate

After completing the training, each participant will receive a training certificate, either in person or delivered by post or email.

10 Liability

The organizer shall be liable only for damages caused by an intentional or grossly negligent breach of duty on the part of the organizer, its legal representatives or vicarious agents. This shall not affect liability for injury to life, limb and health; for breaches of essential contractual obligations; or those that fall under the Product Liability Act. Essential contractual obligations are those whose fulfillment is necessary to achieve the objective of the contract and on whose compliance the contractual partner relies and may regularly rely. In the event of a breach of material contractual obligations, claims shall be limited to typically foreseeable damages, unless such damage was caused intentionally or by gross negligence, and excepting claims for damages arising from injury to life, limb or health.

11 Privacy

The personal data of the participant and/or the contractual partner, or their representatives, will be electronically stored and automatically processed by the organizer for the purpose of carrying out the event, unless express permission is given for other uses and/or for utilization as specified in the respective consent. The includes the forwarding of data to third parties as outlined in the permission granted. The data will not be shared with unauthorized third parties. The organizer reserves the right to send registration confirmations via unencrypted email.

12 Copyright

The work documents and computer software used during the training are protected by copyright. Copying or passing these on to third parties is not permitted, except with the prior consent of the copyright holder.

13 Start/end of contract

The term of the contract begins on the first day of the event and ends on the last day of the event.

14 Salvatory clause

In the event that any individual clauses of these terms and conditions are invalid, the validity of the remaining clauses shall nonetheless remain unaffected.
